1062.01 USE REGULATIONS.

(a) The following rules and regulations shall apply to the rental of the Perry Community Center. A renter/applicant shall:

- (1) Sweep and mop all floors after use, including restroom floors, using cold water, without chemical.
- (2) Clean all restrooms. Extra supplies for the restrooms will be left in the kitchen cupboard.
- (3) Remove all tape from tables and walls, and remove excess marks from walls. All tables and chairs shall be washed and cleaned.
- (4) Fold all chairs used and place the same on the chair caddy, which shall be returned to the storage room when full.
- (5) Supply his or her own dishes, silverware, towels, etc.
- (6) Clean the stove, refrigerators, sinks and counter tops.
- (7) Remove all trash from the premises, without exception, and supply his or her own trash bags. All trash shall be disposed of in the container located in the rear of the premises.
- (8) Not allow any person, for any reason, to sit or stand on the window sills.
- (9) Check all doors to make sure they are tightly closed and locked. (All windows are permanently locked.)
- (10) When departing the premises, leave the key to the Community Center on the kitchen counter of the Center or in the drop box located in the front door of the building.

(b) If the renter/applicant chooses to decorate the Community Center, he or she shall use a ladder and shall not use a table or chairs. The use of nails, pins, staples, thumb tacks and duct (silver) tape is prohibited.

(c) If the renter/applicant chooses not to clean the Community Center after use, he or she may pay to the City, in advance, a cleaning fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00), as set forth in Section 1062.02(a).

(d) There shall be no music in the Community Center after 1:00 a.m.

(e) There shall be a maximum capacity of 200 persons in the Community Center at any one time.

(f) The renter/applicant shall be made aware of the fact that the flooring of the Community Center, inasmuch as it is the original flooring of the building, contains some uneven areas.

(g) Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this section shall result in the forfeiture of the renter/applicant's deposit, at the discretion of Council.

1062.02 FEES; DEPOSITS.

(a) The rental fees and deposit fees to be charged for the use of the Community Center shall be established by resolution of the City Council.

(b) No alcohol will be permitted at graduation open houses.

(c) Deposits shall be refunded to the renter/applicant after the premises has been inspected by the City. If any of the regulations set forth in Section 1062.01 have not been complied with, the City may retain the deposit fee, as provided for in Section 1062.01(g).

(d) Deposit and cleaning fees for regular seasonal users such as civic groups, non-profit events or instructional classes, shall be as set forth in subsection (a) hereof.

*Note: The fee for a single use may be waived on an individual basis by the proper City officials.
