**1 1440.0 PERMIT REQUIRED; APPLICATION; BOND; FEE;
EFFECTIVE PERIOD.**

No person shall move any building or structure upon, along, over or across any street, alley or public place in the City without first obtaining a permit therefor from Council. Upon application for such permit, Council shall approve the route designated for such removal or designate such other route as it deems safer or more practical. Council may also require a bond, in such amount as is determined by Council, to be furnished by the applicant for payment of all damages to public or private property caused by the act or negligence of the applicant or his or her employees. Upon compliance with the requirements of this section, Council shall authorize the City Clerk to issue a permit. The charge for such permit shall be set by the City Council, which sum shall be paid to the City Clerk upon the issuance of the permit. Such permit shall be valid for thirty days only.
